

The Finger Lakes Symphony Orchestra was formed in the fall of 1971 as the Wayne County Symphony with approximately 45 members. As membership grew to represent a larger geographical area, the group incorporated in 1972 under its current name.

FLSO performance venues include area colleges and high schools, wineries, outdoor summer Pops concerts, area churches, and the Smith Opera House in Geneva, NY.

The current roster of 50 plus members is comprised of a very diverse group, including professionals of many vocations, musicians, and students in the Greater Rochester and Finger Lakes areas.

Eligibility:

Auditions are open to all instrumental students through grade 12. Applicants must be residents of Ontario, Seneca, Monroe, Wayne, Livingston, Orleans, Genesee, Wyoming, or Yates counties. (Note: pianists and vocalists are not eligible, nor are previous winners).

This year's winner will perform a solo with the Finger Lakes Symphony Orchestra during their Annual Spring Concert on April 10, 2010, and also will receive a cash award of \$150. In the event of multiple winners, a cash award of \$200 will be split between the winners.

Auditions:

Will be held on **Saturday** afternoon, **February 6, 2010** at the **Harley School** at 1981 Clover St., Rochester, NY 14618.

Please prepare any one movement from a solo concerto or showpiece from standard orchestral repertoire (Baroque, Classical, Romantic and Contemporary music is acceptable).

Eligible applicants will be notified by phone to arrange an audition time during the week prior to auditions. Accompaniment is recommended but not mandatory for audition. **Please be sure that your audition piece has orchestra accompaniment.**

You will be given a maximum of eight minutes including any setup and tear down necessary for the audition. Please provide your own accompanist. No accompaniment other than piano will be allowed. Remember, winners will be performing with the orchestra.
